Curriculums

Practical Life

Practical life activities include skills for everyday living that develop a child's coordination of movements, increase his self-confidence and independence with each accomplishment.



Sensorial

The sensorial materials are used to help children to refine their five senses: listening, seeing, touching, smelling, tasting, and exploring the physical properties of their environment.



Language
